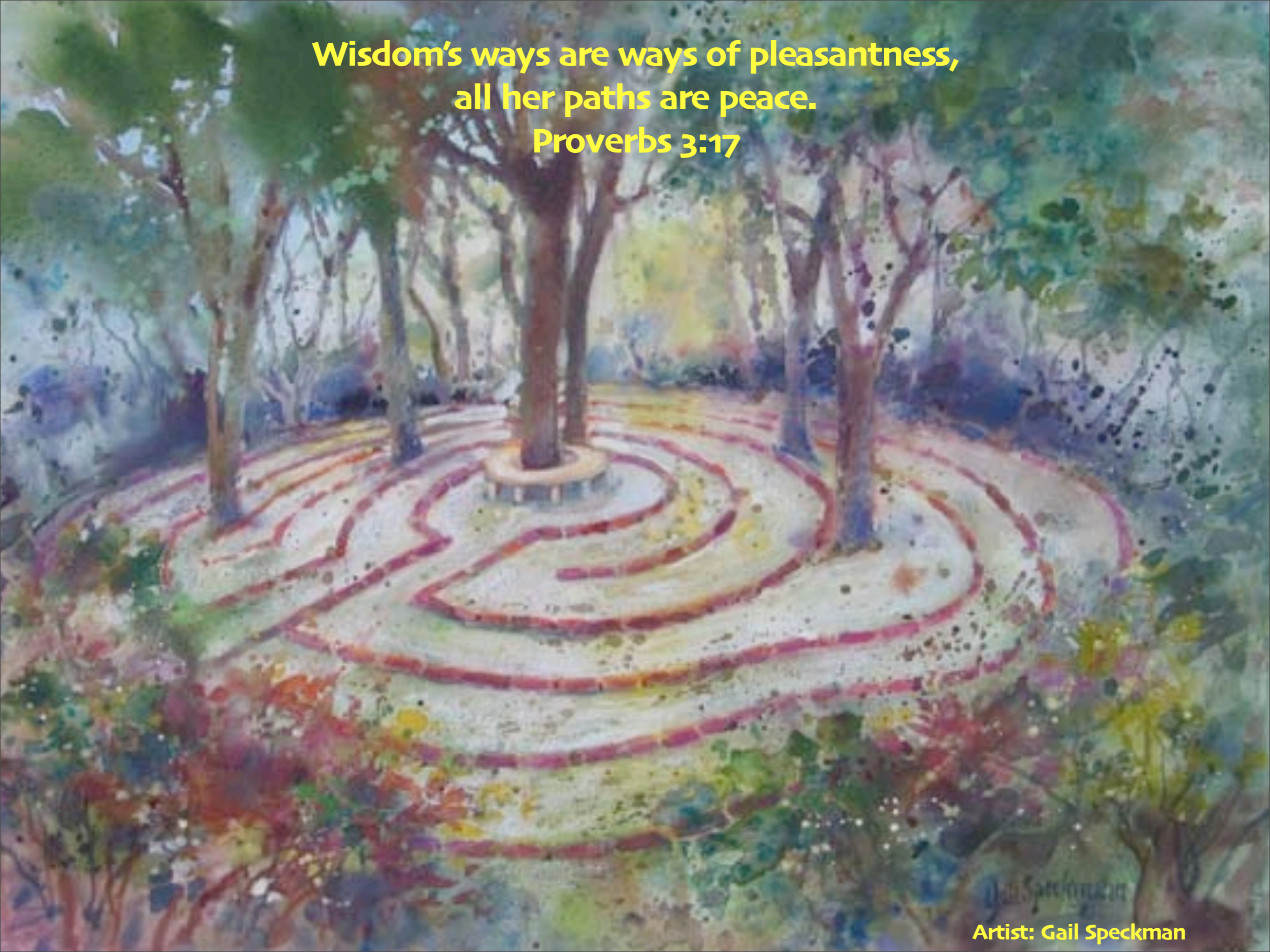

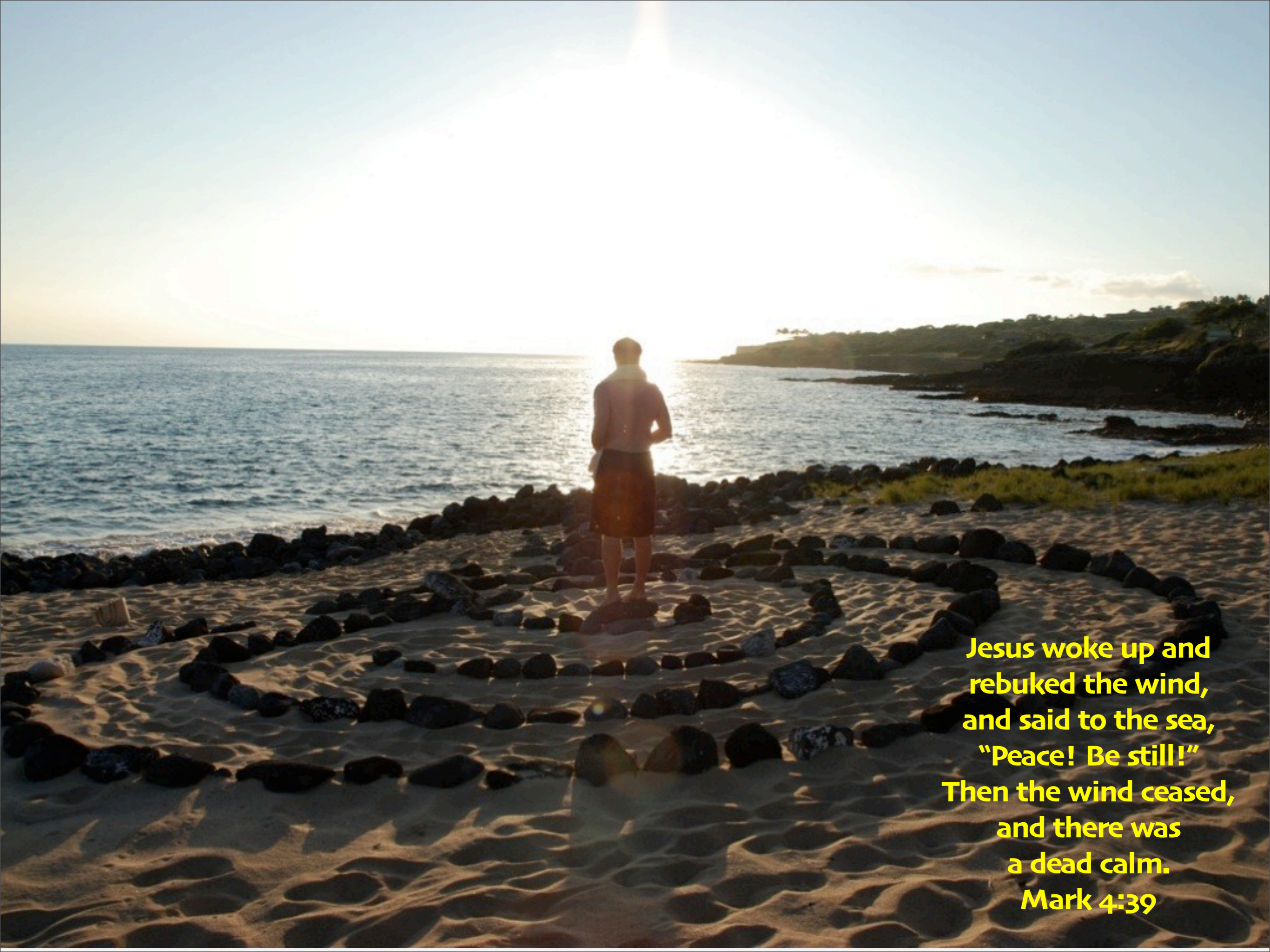


While they were talking about [Jesus' rising and appearing to Simon and the travelers on the road to Emmaus], Jesus himself stood among them and said, "Peace be with you."
