














Labyrinths are designs that consist of a single, winding path that begins at the periphery and leads to a central space.


The way out is on the same path, but in the opposite direction.






You are being led to the center.













The cross is the starting point for building labyrinths.












Hansen Art labyrinths, 7 circuit classical squared, with highlighted crosses.




"May I never boast of anything but the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world." Galatians 6:14


We start with a small 3 circuit labyrinth









Step I: Make a cross with four dots




"Seed pattern" for 3 circuit labyrinth

Step 2: Starting at the top of the cross make an arc from I in the center to I on the right.






Step 3: Make an arc from 2 on the left side to 2 on the right side.







Step 4: Make an arc from 3 on the left side to 3 on the right side.






Step 5: Make an arc from 4 on the left side to 4 on the right side.







Congratulations! You have made a 3 circuit labyrinth.



Labyrinths can be made from any material. They can be small or big.

Bricks placed in the grass




Lava stones on a beach


Pray with the your labyrinth using your finger.









